Consultation instructions

Consultation sessions for the area-based working groups:

- Urgent and non-urgent consultations related to young people being treated by Tyks Adolescent Psychiatry.
- Consultations related to the preparation of a non-urgent outpatient referral.
- Local arrangement of treatment and urgency of access to treatment, the guestionnaires to be appended to the referral must be completed.
- Questions may be submitted as phone or paper consultations if, once the referring party has received a response, that same party may continue as the patient's treatment provider, e.g. non-urgent medication questions. Paper consultations must be addressed to the centralised referral processing service (Tyks Psychiatric Referral Processing, PO Box 52, 20521 Turku).

As a general rule, a referral for a young person will be sent to the relevant working groups in accordance with the municipal division below. If justified due to the individual being a student studying in another municipality or for other reasons, an Adolescent Psychiatry working group other than that of the individual's home municipality may also be selected.

Consultations with the Adolescent Psychiatry Ward (Tel. 02 313 1717):

Consultations on intensive outpatient care with Adolescent Psychiatry (Tel. 02 313 1722):

- the consultation concerns a young person in intensive outpatient care, or
- the request concerns an urgent consultation regarding a young person who does not have a treatment contact with Tyks Adolescent Psychiatry, but emergency inpatient treatment is not considered pertinent in the situation.
